





  - Carryover Threshold
  - Consortia Impacts


## Governor's Proposed FY 2223 Budget

- Much to CELEBRATE!
  - COLA @ 5.33%K12, CAEP, CCs, Adults in Correctional Facilities Program
  - \*New Funding\* Healthcare Vocational Education
    - \$130M Over Three Years
      - \$30M FY 2223; \$50M FY 2-324; \$50M FY 2-425
  - Dual Enrollment Investment @ \$500M, One-Time
  - AB 540 Financial Assistance Grants @ \$20M

# Governor's Proposed FY 2223 Budget (cont)


- Fee Waivers
  - Exam Fees @ \$24M
  - Credentialing Fees @ \$12M
- CCC Teacher Credentialing Partnership Program @
  - +\$5M






